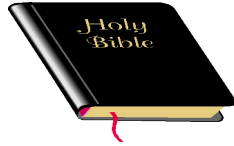

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Friends,

Greetings! As I write this it is apparent that many places in our country have begun to open-up and resume business and commerce heading toward a resumption of what we remember as *normal*. Unfortunately, the church is not there yet. We had our May Session meeting via Zoom technology where we were all in our homes, yet we could see and hear each other. While there are indications of restrictions being relaxed, it is not as easy as simply saying that *on such and such a date we will resume our previous scheduled worship services*. Many ideas were shared by the Elders including having worship on the front lawn with people invited to bring their lawn chairs or possibly sit in their vehicle in the parking lot. What I can tell you is that when we are prepared to resume worship, in whatever format, you will be informed.

The First Sunday this June is Trinity Sunday on the Church calendar. The historic symbol for the Trinity is three interlocked circles. The Trinity is not some mathematical absurdity that $1+1+1=1$. The Trinity is a human statement about the personhood of God. God abhors sin. God's desire is for a close, loving relationship between us and God's self. The Christian faith announces that this has been accomplished through the three persons of the Trinity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit means that the mystery beyond us, the

mystery among us, and the mystery within us are all the same mystery. The Trinity is a way of expressing how we experience God. Our experience is not limited by time or space, because God transcends all of these and more.

We worship the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, whom he called *Abba*, Father, who transcends time. We worship the Lord Jesus Christ as the Lord of Life who transcends space. When Philip said to Jesus: *Lord, show us the Father, and we shall be satisfied*. Jesus' reply is instructive: *He who has seen me has seen the Father; how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? ... The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority; but the Father who dwells in me does his works* (John 14:8-10).

We worship the Holy Spirit as the presence of God with us who transcends space and time as an abiding presence. This is the mystery of the Trinity. The Holy Spirit is God's still, small voice that continues to speak to us and invites us to enter into a relationship that will take us from where we are to where God wants us to be. This is Good News! And it is God's Holy Spirit who binds us together although the Corona Virus Pandemic temporarily keeps us physically separate.

There is encouraging news daily but it is far too soon to sound the *all clear!* What I can tell you is that as soon as it is safe, we will resume worship and the activities that we believe are part of our calling as followers of Jesus Christ. In the meantime, as I have said before, let's covenant to stay connected. Don't hesitate to call or email friends to see how they are doing. A friendly greeting and

remembrance can certainly brighten another's day.

I want to thank everyone who has been so faithful in sending in their offering and participating in the candy bar, gift cards, and greeting cards fundraising sales. It has been helpful. Session has approved the Fundraising Committee's request for a Chicken Barbeque fundraiser. It has been scheduled for Saturday June 6th from 2 to 6 p.m. This one will be Take-Out Only! We will be required to wear masks and keep a physical distance. Please look for additional information in the rest of the newsletter. Help with set-up and clean-up is necessary and appreciated.

Please review the announcements and information contained in the rest of this newsletter. They will help us to plan for what we may or may not be allowed to do in the coming days and weeks. I will continue to write a weekly letter with the Scripture readings for the Lord's Day until we receive the *all clear*. I hope you will find it helpful.

By the grace of God, we are one people, and together, part of the Body of Christ in this time and place. I look forward to sharing with you the worthy and sacred work of worship, mission, and ministry at our Lord's Linway Church.

Saturday help is needed setting up outside, taking orders, and clean-up afterwards.

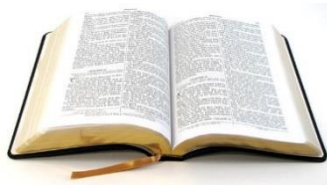
Contact Jamie Stewart at 412-419-7179 if you are able to help on Saturday.
