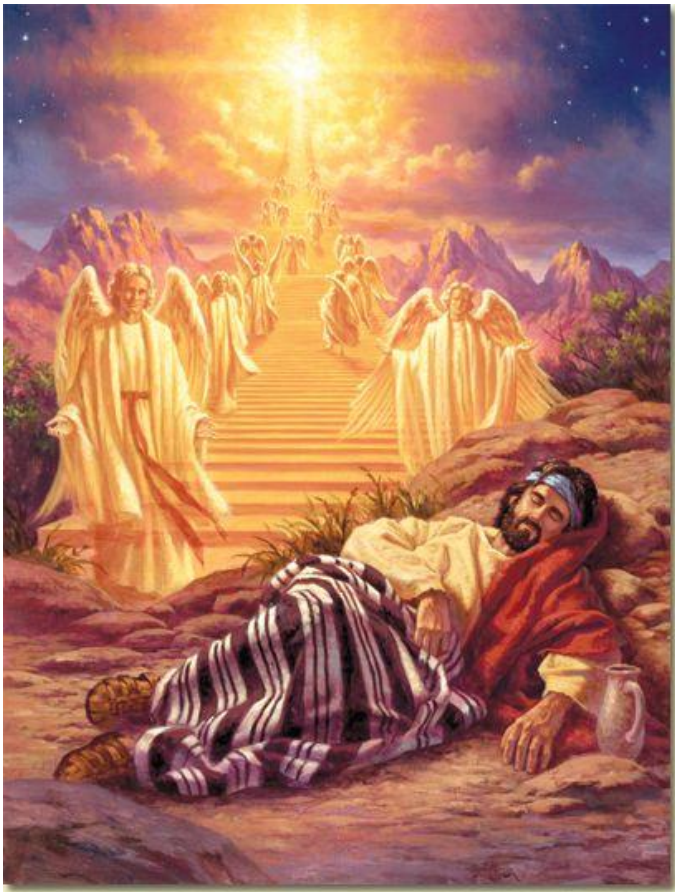
The following scripture readings have been suggested by the Presbytery for this week:
