

This Maundy Thursday, March 28, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper the way Jesus and the disciples did. They gathered together not in a worship service, but around a table to celebrate the Passover. Everyone is welcome to gather downstairs in our Social Hall at 6:30 p.m. to share a simple meal of soup (chicken noodle or chicken rice soup) and bread. Following the meal, Pastor Larry will share the radical way that Jesus broke all the rules and redefined the Passover so that not only Jews were invited to the table, but all who would follow Jesus! There is no charge for the meal, but a free will basket will be available should you wish to

contribute. Please invite friends, family, youth, and children to join us as we remember and reflect on the first Lord's Supper so many years ago.

Good Friday Tenebrae Service 7:30 p.m.

The Good Friday Tenebrae Service is a solemn service in which we remember Jesus' life, crucifixion, and death. Stemming from Latin, the word "Tenebrae" means "darkness." Such a definition is suitable for this service, which centers around the increasing darkness of the church as the lights on the candelabra are extinguished.

A special candelabra is used during Tenebrae. After each reading, whether from the Psalms or gospels, a candle is extinguished until one is left. By the end of the service, the church is cast into darkness, except for the continual light of the Christ candle, symbolizing Christ as the Light of the World.

As a service with deep biblical meaning, each part of Tenebrae sets the mood for the congregation as they consider the darkness of that day as the Savior hung on the cross and died for the sins of the world. At the conclusion of the service, all who are present exit the sanctuary in silence. Please consider attending this powerful, moving service in person.

Congregational Meeting: April 14

Wallace is the Associate Minister for Congregational Support & Emerging Ministries for the Pittsburgh Presbytery and also currently the Acting Head of Staff. He has been one of the individuals assisting the Linway Transition Team.

Transition to New Pastor

This month, we've taken a significant step in our transition to a new pastor. On March 10, the congregation approved the members of the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC). The PNC will soon be meeting with members of Presbytery to initiate the search process for our next pastor. I encourage you to keep them in your prayers.

Another crucial aspect of this process is a Congregational Survey, which aims to assess our current state. In mid to late April, you'll be receiving the survey. While we recognize that completing the survey will require an investment of your time, we deeply appreciate your participation. The survey results will be professionally analyzed and will serve as a vital tool to guide Linway's future.

Should you have any questions or concerns during the transition period, please don't hesitate to reach out to the Transition Team, the PNC, or a member of Session. We are committed to addressing all inquiries promptly.

As we journey through this process, let's continue to lift up Linway Church, the PNC and the Transition Team in your daily prayers. With faith and prayer, we'll discern God's plan for our congregation.

RETREAT 2024 ~ April 26th thru 28th REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Sunday April 7th

The Linway Christian Education Committee welcomes you to join your Linway family as we "retreat" from everyday life at Ligonier Camp & Conference Center (LCCC), <u>Friday evening</u>, <u>April 26th thru Sunday morning</u>, <u>April 28th</u>

The 2024 retreat will provide activities for fun, fellowship, and Christian education for all ages and is a great way to get to know members of your Linway family. LCCC has private rooms, prepared meals, and beautiful surroundings.

The weekend cost includes meals and lodging based on a two-night package and cannot be reduced for only one night of lodging. Discounted weekend rates for <u>Linway members</u>, their immediate family members, or anyone who <u>participates in the life of Linway</u> are \$60 per adult / \$30 per child (3 years thru 12th grade). Linway children or youth program participants attending the weekend <u>without an adult family member</u> will be charged the adult discount price of \$60. Any guest who does not meet discounted rate guidelines, regardless of age, will be charged the full fee of \$116.

Attendance for only part of the weekend <u>without overnight lodging</u> is encouraged for those who have limited availability or would like to experience the retreat (maybe for the first time) without committing to the entire weekend. Meal cost without lodging ranges from \$8-\$12, based on the meal. **LASER TAG**, supervised by LCCC staff, will be an <u>optional</u> Saturday afternoon activity at the cost of <u>\$15 per participant</u>.

Anyone on LCCC property for any amount of time is required to submit a LCCC Release of Liability form. The form is available at www.ligoniercamp.org, from Amy Gida or the Linway Church office. MINORS attending the retreat without a parent or legal guardian must have their form completed and signed BEFORE arriving at LCCC. Additional health forms are no longer required for laser tag participants.

Pets are not permitted on LCCC property. Smoking and vaping are allowed only in designated outdoor areas.
